

RF/CF Iron Sight Rifle Offhand Steel Plate/Bowling Pin Rules

- Each shooter can shoot 1 each rimfire lever action and semiauto Iron Sights **ONLY** and 1 each of Centerfire pistol cartridge lever action and pistol cartridge carbine Iron Sights.

- Timed event. • Penalty of 5 sec. per missed target.

- Shooting distance 30 yards.

2 stages:

- Stage 1. 10 shots to be loaded in gun (Lever Action) or magazine/tub fed (semiauto).

- Lever Action, Tub Fed and Magazines guns will be loaded at shooting table.

- Targets will be 8 or 10 steel plates and/or 2 bowling pins at each end.

- All Steel to be shot first then bowling pins (if present).

- Stage 2. 10 shots loaded in gun or magazine and 4 rounds on shooting table.

- Lever Action guns will be loaded at shooting table.

- Targets will be 10 steel plates and 4 bowling pins (2 bowling pins on each side of steel).

- Stage 2, will be shot all steel first using 10 rounds in gun or magazine, then each shooter will reload 4 rounds in the lever action or 4 rounds into magazine. No speed loaders to be used, Shooter will manually load magazines on the clock after shooting steel.

- Reason is this will equal out for those shooting a magazine fed and a tube fed semiauto gun.

- Any missed targets count as a 5 sec. penalty.

- These rules will apply to both rimfire & centerfire.

- All targets and number of targets due to change from shoot to shoot.

1. SAFETY:

When line is called "COLD" firearms may not be touched by anyone.

If the firing tables are set up in the field, NO firearms are to be handled and must be cased until shooter is called to the firing line.

While firing and reloading you must keep the muzzle of the firearm pointed downrange.

First offense will result in a warning by the RO.

Second offense will result in your disqualification from the match.

Firearms must be brought to and from the firing table unloaded, magazines out with the slide locked back or the cylinder out. When moving firearms, the muzzle must be kept pointing up.

Eye and ear protection is required for all competitors; eye protection is required for spectators (ear protection is recommended).

Only the competitor and Range Officer are allowed at the firing table. (Exception: Coaching is allowed for new shooters, coaches must stand on the opposite side as the RO.)

The rimfire match is to be shot with 22 rimfire only (high velocity or standard velocity).

No 22 magnums, 17 HMR, or hypervelocity rimfire loads may be used.
