

## Target Policy

Recently, it was brought to my attention that a member or guest was using the image of a political figure as a target. Not only is this in poor taste, it could also jeopardize the Chatuge Gun Club's lease with our landlord, the US Forestry Service. Though someone may feel this is a freedom of speech issue, the Club has the right to address any action that threatens our lease or charter. Thus, effective immediately, imagery, photos or pictures of people may not be used as a target on the Chatuge Gun Club range or at an organized event. Standard bullseye paper targets and traditional action-shooting targets, humanoid type silhouette targets, animal targets, and unrecognizable generic images of characters such as zombies, thugs and bad guys may be used as targets. Anyone violating this policy will be asked to leave the range immediately and may risk suspension or loss of membership to the Chatuge Gun Club.
