NOTE: The Shotgun Group shoots Trap EVERY WEDNESDAY beginning at 1000 until all squads have fired. It is recommended that you are at the range by 0930 if you want to be squaddled anywhere but last. Avoid range maintenance before 0930.

NEW WARNING LIGHTS



As no doubt noticed by those of you who have been to the range recently, the new warning lights have been installed.

There are four (4)(?) lights, along with four (4)(?) on/off switches, spaced along the firing line and one (1) light facing the parking area.

The purpose of the lights is to provide an additional means to both inform and remind those on or around the firing line, including those just arriving or who may have been temporarily off the line, that the line is cold and that there are people down range. The key word is “additional”. Existing range rules and range etiquette must still be followed. Anyone wanting the line to go cold must verbally communicate that desire to all persons on or around the firing line. After obtaining an acknowledgement from all involved that the firing line is cold and verifying that the requirements for a cold line have been met, the lights then may be activated. Stated differently, neither the range rules nor range etiquette will allow anyone to just activate the lights without first verbally communicating and coordinating with fellow shooters.

Once it is verified that everyone has returned from down range, then the process is reversed. First, the desire for a hot firing line must be verbally communicated and then, after securing an acknowledgment from all on or around the line, the lights may be deactivated.

If you are at the range alone, it is important that you still activate the lights before going down range so that anyone arriving at the range is clear as to your whereabouts.

It is also very important that the lights not be left on overnight; therefore, if you are the last one at the range, be sure that the lights are off when you leave.

Safety is the responsibility of all members. The Board believes that the warning lights will assist in our ongoing efforts to maintain a good safe shooting environment at the range.
